The Water For People Committees of Iowa and Nebraska have joined together to hold a shotgun event featuring trap and skeet shooting. The event will be held in Omaha on the first day of the Iowa Water Pollution Control Association (IWPCA) 2008 Annual Conference in Council Bluffs.
